della storia, mentre l'Iran minaccia che il prezzo del petrolio è destinato a più che raddoppiare.

Il regime iraniano ha affermato che il petrolio arriverà a costare 200 dollari al barile, rispetto all'attuale prezzo di 90 dollari al barile.

Le conseguenze, tra cui la carenza di approvvigionamenti di carburante e le ripercussioni economiche, saranno significative, e hanno portato allo stanziamento di 400 milioni di barili di petrolio gestiti dall'Agenzia internazionale per l'energia.

Il presidente francese Emmanuel Macron, che ha ospitato il vertice dei leader del G7, ha dichiarato che questo provvedimento rappresenta 20 giorni di flusso di petrolio attraverso lo Stretto di Hormuz.

Iran threatens the price of oil will more than double.

The Iranian regime says oil will cost 200 U-S dollars a barrel, up from its current price of 90 dollars a barrel.

The consequences, including fuel supply shortages and economic ramifications will be significant, triggering the release of 400 million barrels of oil managed by the the International Energy Agency.

French President Emmanuel Macron, who hosted the G7 leaders meeting, says this release represents 20 days of oil flow through the Strait of Hormuz.

The United Nations Security Council is demanding Iran stop its attacks on nations not involved in its conflict with the US and Israel, citing a violation of international law.

A draft resolution on the issue, was voted 13 to zero and has been supported by more than 130 member states of the U-N's most
